I know that like us, many of you are also providing these services to citizens during this Covid-19 pandemic. And that's why I would like to share some safety tips with you to protect you from the Novel Corona Virus....

Disclaimer: These instructions are not SOPs for regular work but intended to highlight additional safety measures to be taken by sanitation workers

Before leaving home for your work, you must



1. Wear full sleeve and full-length clothes



3. Carry the **Emergency pass** issued by ULB



5. Gloves, mask, apron, shoes (if mask is unavailable, then use a clean cloth in 2-3 layers to cover nose and mouth)



2. Cover wounds with water-proof band-aid



4. Carry water and soap to wash hands



6. Carry extra set of clothes

When you reach the workplace, you must



Wash hands with soap




Wear PPEs as per recommendations



Draw circles outside the toilet block to make users maintain distance



Clean the toilet block by wearing PPEs



Instruct users to maintain distance of at least 1 m & to wash their hands with soap after using toilet



Collect user charges while wearing gloves



Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.

Wash hands with soap before having any food

When you finish your work



Remove

safety gears



Wash hands and face



Change clothes and put all in a bag



and return to home



Wear mask/cloth Before meeting anyone in the family, first wash clothes and PPEs with soap and hang them in a sunny dry place

Contact a doctor immediately if you have any cough/fever or running nose
